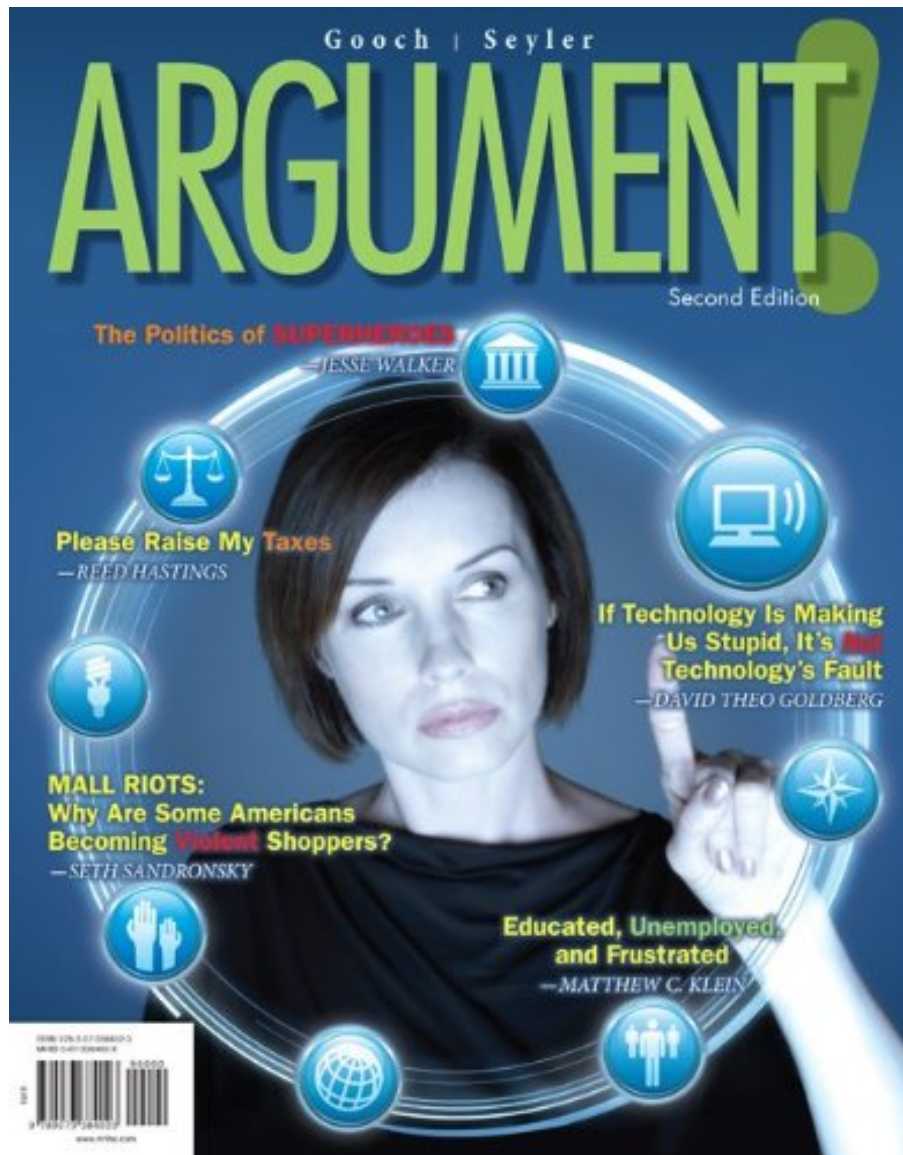

I use this text in my Rhetoric 1302 course. Here are the highlights:

- Chapters are organized so that concepts build upon each other nicely; students often refer to concepts from previous chapters when discussing later chapters.
- Concepts of classical rhetoric in accessible language.

- Visually engaging: attractive layout, including visual examples of rhetorical arguments.
- Examples of speeches, essays, op eds, billboards, TV ads, cartoons... from popular culture and current events that students relate to.
