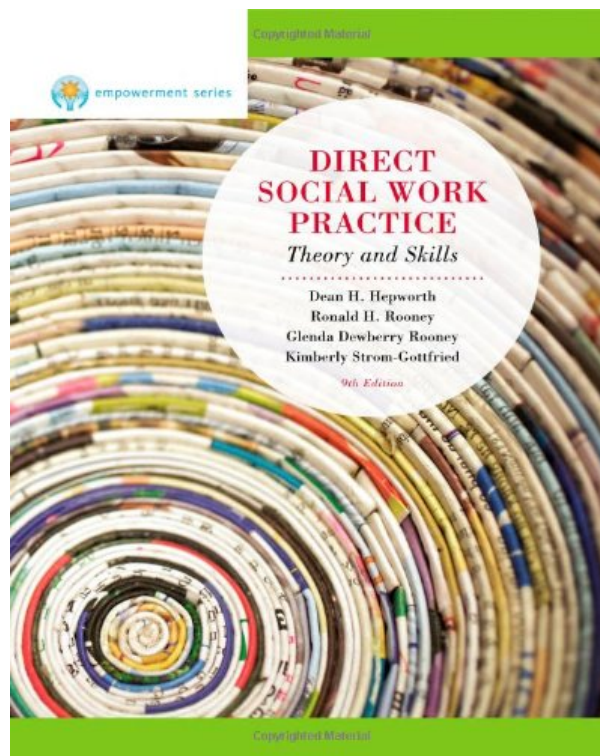
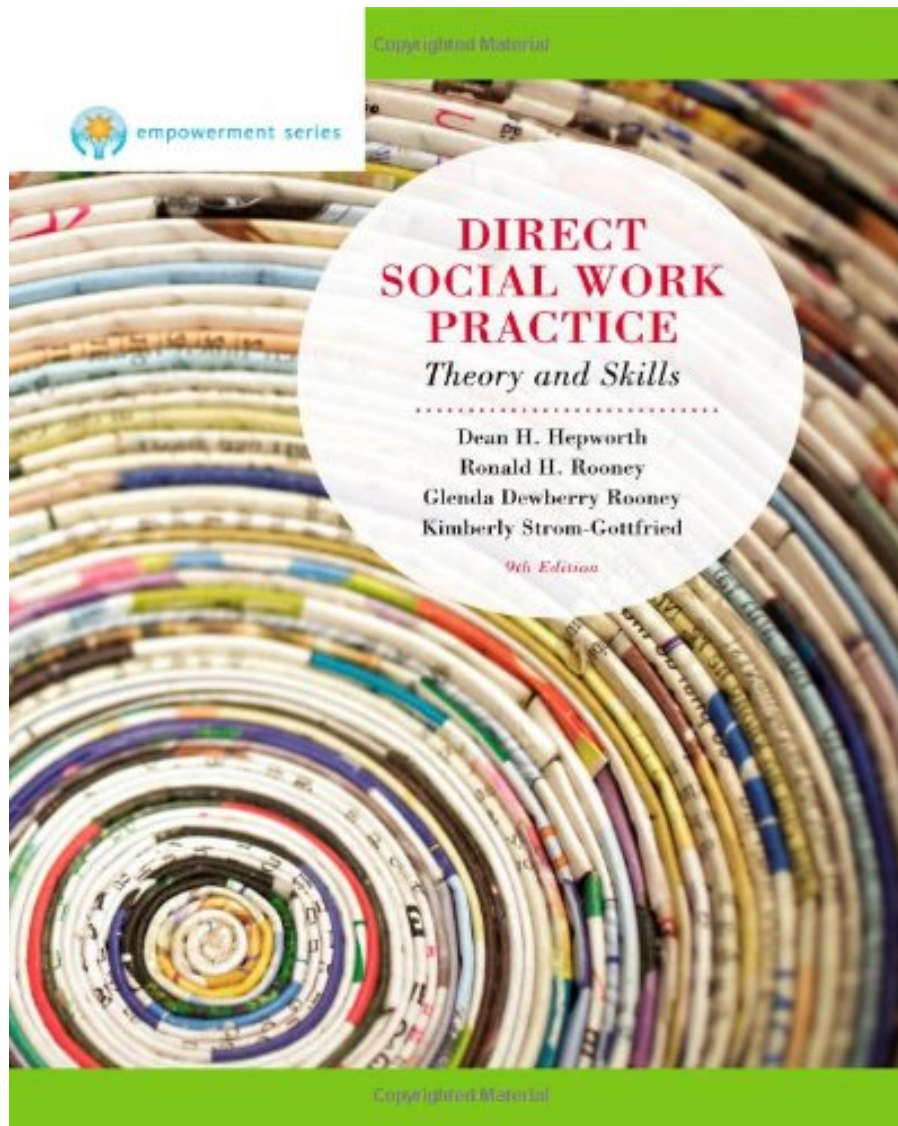

I read this book as part of a Master's Social Work class. My classmates and I all complained regularly about this book. It is poorly written - the verbiage is awkward and murky - many concepts could have been more effectively explained with far fewer words. The authors seemed to think that the bigger the word, the more effective the communication. After a while, the reader's mind just shuts down from working too hard trying to figure out exactly what the Authors are saying.

Also, there were very few pages that didn't have at least one grammatical error. Proper grammar should be textbook 101 in my opinion. Another review stated the textbook was dry - which is giving it far too much credit. I have never fallen asleep so often while reading a textbook.
